	If not, borrow one from the Sea Tow Foundation! Find the closest Life Jacket Loaner Station near you at www.boatingsafety.com/map.
	WHERE ARE THE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS, EMERGENCY FLARES AND FIRST AID KIT ON THE BOAT?  Make sure everyone else knows, too!
	DOUBLE CHECK THAT YOUR NAVIGATION LIGHTS AND HORN WORK BEFORE LEAVING THE DOCK.
	CHECK THE BILGE.  Make sure it isn't filled with water before the boat is underway.
	CHECK THE GAS GAUGE AND LET THE CAPTAIN KNOW HOW MUCH FUEL YOU HAVE.
	HOW DOES THE WEATHER LOOK?  Don't head out on the water if it looks like it's going to storm. Check the weather on the VHF radio and help keep track of it during the boat trip.
	MAKE SURE EVERYONE ON BOARD HAS PLENTY OF DRINKING WATER AND THAT THE SOBER SKIPPER IS DESIGNATED BEFORE LEAVING THE DOCK.  The Sober Skipper can take the pledge at soberskipper.com/pledge.
	ASK THE CAPTAIN TO SHOW YOU THE PLANNED ROUTE ON A MAP OR CHART.  Then you can help keep a watch for buoys and navigation markers during the trip.
	Last thing to check: IS EVERYONE READY TO HAVE FUN?
